SOME LEARNINGS FROM PGS

Key sustainable criteria and indicators

Locally defined - Agroecology framework

Farm scale - complexity (biodiversity, inputs, circular designs, energy)

Territory scale (commercialisation, local articulations, traditional knowledge)

Participation – definitions, following up, guarantee

Indicators concept - transition approach

Local definition of the transition – broaden definition of the red lines and desirable situations

Guarantee systems – more than a seal – sustainable transition driving force
