We hope, through this, to be able to know, firstly, if climate change is really considered in the methodologies of sustainability assessment. Secondly, to have an overview of the role of differentiation approaches in climate change mitigation but also of the resilience capacities of these approaches to climate disruption. The final objectives of this session will be to better understand how to integrate the urgency of climate change into differentiation strategies and to provide avenues for discussion and research on this topic.]
